

WORKING IN WAREHOUSING & DISTRIBUTION (FACTORY HAND)

This course is designed to provide students with the opportunity to learn specific skills related to working in a factory environment as well as generic employability skills. Delivery of the course will be workplace based learning giving the students the opportunity to apply the knowledge and skills they have learned in a real work situation at factory/warehouse in and around South Eastern suburbs.

Generic employability skills including the language, literacy and numeracy required for this industry will also be blended throughout the course.
